Dr. Mark T. Walsh has 41 years of clinical specialization experience caring for patients with Upper Extremity Dysfunction. Dr. Walsh holds three graduate degrees in physical therapy and has been credentialed as a Board-Certified Hand Therapist since 1991. Mark has held multiple part time faculty appointments, recently as Assistant Clinical Professor (Adjunct) at Drexel University (1997-2015) and presently as Professor (Adjunct) at Thomas Jefferson University in the department of Rehabilitation Sciences. Mark is internationally recognized as an accomplished author of 22 peer reviewed journal and book chapters, and has presented original research and 250 invited lectures related to hand and upper extremity rehabilitation. He served on the JHT Editorial Board for over 20 years and was co-editor for the special edition on Pain. Previous appointments include the Hand Rehabilitation Foundation and the American Society of Hand Therapy as Director of Education. Mark's other related professional accomplishments include recipient of the ASHT's prestigious Natalie Barr Lectureship (1998), Honored Senior Visiting Professor, Rehabilitation of the Hand Conference, Philadelphia (2004), and the Dorothy B. Kaufman Lectureship Honored Professor (2009). Most notable is the recognition Mark has received over many years from the ASHT and the HTCC for his contributions to hand therapy.
